FEBRUARY

BLUECROSS BLUESHIELD ASSOCIATION - MATERNITY SERVICES

Olathe Medical Center's maternity services was named a 2021-2023 Blue Distinction Center for Specialty Care. This national designation is awarded to healthcare facilities who demonstrated better overall patient satisfaction and a lower percentage of early elective deliveries. OMC is also a Blue Distinction Center+ for cardiac care and spine surgery.

MARCH

INGRAM'S HEROES IN HEALTHCARE

Ingram's Magazine selected two people from Olathe Health as 2021 Heroes in Healthcare. Stephanee Evers, MD, Emergency Medicine physician at Olathe Medical Center, was selected for her leadership during the COVID-19 pandemic; and Doris Chrisenbery, Ambassador, received the award recognizing her years of service and leadership as a volunteer.

APRIL

FOUR-STAR RATINGS FOR OMC AND MCMC FROM CMS

Olathe Medical Center and Miami County Medical Center received a four-star rating from the CMS Overall Hospital Quality Star Ratings. The overall star rating is based on how well a hospital performs across different areas of quality, such as treating heart attacks and pneumonia, readmission rates, and safety of care.

IBM WATSON HEALTH TOP HOSPITAL

IBM Watson Health identified the top hospitals from a rigorous evaluation of 2,675 short-term, acute care, non-federal hospitals in the U.S. Olathe Medical Center was one of the top 20 large community hospitals in the country. The list recognizes excellence in clinical outcome, operational efficiency, patient experience, financial health, and contributions to community health.

U.S. NEWS AND WORLD REPORT HIGH PERFORMING HOSPITAL

Olathe Medical Center was named a High Performing Hospital in Kidney Failure, Stroke, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease and Heart Failure for 2021-22 by U.S. News and World Report. The High Performing rating recognizes hospitals who provide care that is significantly better than the national average. Fewer than a third of all hospitals received a high-performance rating.

AMERICAN COLLEGE OF CARDIOLOGY PLATINUM AWARD

Olathe Medical Center received the 2021 Platinum (Highest) award for heart attack patient care. This is the tenth consecutive year OMC has earned the platinum recognition. The NCDR Chest Pain - MI Registry Platinum Performance Achievement Award is given to the top four percent of hospitals across the country.

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION/AMERICAN STROKE ASSOCIATION GET WITH THE GUIDELINES

The AHA/ASA awarded Olathe Medical Center recognition for stroke and diabetes care with the 2021 Get With The Guidelines Stroke Elite Gold Plus achievement award and the Target: Stroke Honor Roll Elite and Target: Type 2 Diabetes Honor Roll Award.

CHIME HEALTHCARE'S MOST WIRED AWARD

The College of Healthcare Information Management Executive (CHIME) chose Olathe Health as a recipient of the 2021 CHIME Healthcare's Most Wired Award. This award recognizes hospitals and health systems that are at the forefront of using healthcare IT. This is the third consecutive year Olathe Health has received this award.

OCTOBER

BLUECROSS BLUESHIELD OF KANSAS CITY - TOP PERFORMER

Olathe Health's primary care clinics earned TC+ designation from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas City (Blue KC) for exceeding the 70th percentile for both cost efficiency and clinical quality in 2020. More notably, we were named the best-performing primary care practice in the Blue KC network in quality. We also rank in the top 20th percentile in the network for cost. This means patients who choose Olathe Health will receive high-quality, low-cost healthcare services.

INGRAM'S KANSAS CITY'S TOP DOCTORS - RAVI K. YARLAGADDA, MD, FACC, FHRS

In the October 2021 issue of *Ingram's Magazine*, only 25 physicians from the Kansas City area were chosen as Top Doctors. Ravi K. Yarlagadda, MD, FACC, FHRS, an electrophysiologist with Olathe Health, was one of the elite physicians honored. Dr. Yarlagadda was integral to Olathe Medical Center becoming the first hospital in North America to receive a commercial license for the EP Navigator to treat complex heart rhythm disorders. He was the first doctor in Kansas to perform cryoablation to restore normal heart rhythm. More recently, he began performing left atrial appendage closure, a lifesaving, minimally invasive procedure enabling atrial fibrillation patients to eliminate blood thinners without increased risk for stroke.
